Emergency Action Plan

Prior to any training session or game (home or away) taking place the team manager/ coach must:

- Ensure that an FA qualified first aider is present prior to the session beginning/kick-off.
- Ensure that the first aider has an FA first aid qualification which is in date.
- Ensure that a fully stocked first aid kit is present, and all items within the kit are within date (where applicable).
- Ensure that a fully charged mobile phone is available.
- Ensure that they know the post code of the pitch they are playing at and the access route for emergency vehicles.
- Ensure that they know the location of the nearest defibrillator(s).
- Ensure that all player medical equipment required for medical conditions i.e., inhalers are in a safe place and readily available.
- Ensure that the match day environment is safe and appropriate for football.
- Ensure that they have a colleague who can support them should an incident occur.
- Ensure that that they are aware of their player medical conditions and that they have player emergency contact numbers.
- Act in line with the FA First Aid Qualification should they need to.
- After an incident complete a club accident form to the Club Welfare Officer.
- In an emergency dial 999 or 112 (gives GPS to emergency services).
